Schools: You can use the produce/crop list (pg3) to find vendors of locally produced items. Or you can refer to the farm list (pg7) to find a particular farm. Either way, the farm hyperlink will take you to the farm page to provide contact information, crops, the seasons when products are available, and the farm description.

Farmers: Please use the school list (pg8) to find school district buyers looking for the produce, legumes, meat or grain that you want to sell. Nutrition Services Directors' contact information is listed and it is recommended that you send an introductory email and follow up with a phone call or an arranged visit to sample your product. Sending weekly fresh sheets detailing your produce availability and price may also be recommended. School districts will expect you to deliver your high quality produce. Your farm may not be expected to supply the entire "estimated amount needed" by a school unless you have a forward contract in place with the school district. We recommend using this directory in conjunction with <u>Tips for Farmers Selling to Schools</u>.
